News from the Senior Class

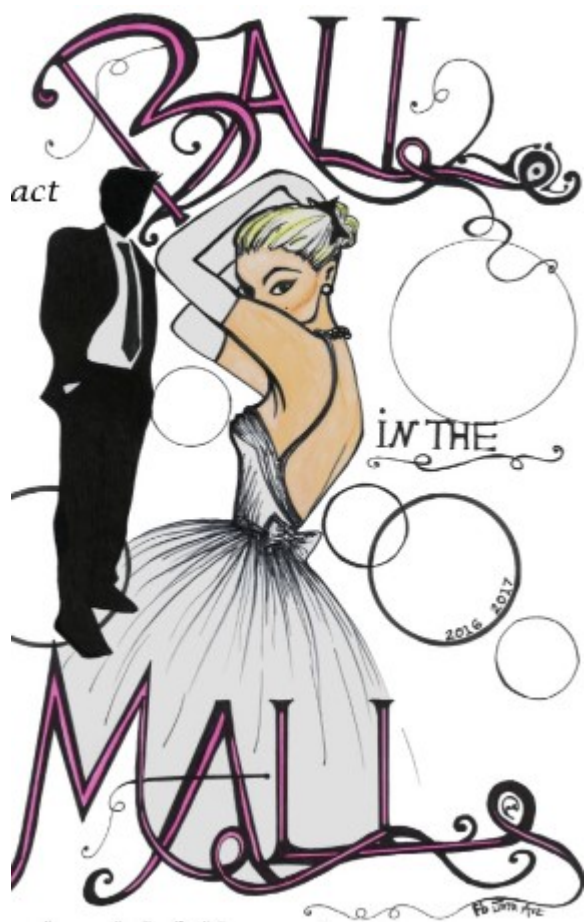
Several students elected to participate in a Work Placement over the holiday break. Work Placement gives the students insights into possible career options and further training opportunities.
